

New Deck and Dry Space for Outside Bar

The work on this project is being done by VBC volunteers: Frank Resar, Tom Evans, Tom Talliano, Larry Uebbing, Georgann Wachter, John Heideman, Fred Ostrander, Jack Januzzie, and Mike Wachter. Yes, the average age of our construction crew is 75! The oldest member weighs in at 85 and the youngest at 65. Thanks also to Kuhn Fabricating for cutting and bending the flashings. Want to help? The DuxxBak brand decking is water tight. As a result, the space under the deck will be dry when it rains, allowing us to use the outside bar when the skies open. This project will be completed this fall, and is fully funded by Blue Gavel fundraisers. These include the pig roast, clam bake, spaghetti dinner, and Membership Raffle. Member participation in these fundraising events will help Blue Gavel continue to help the club be "The place to be" every day, every week, and every year. In the spring, Blue Gavel plans a complete rebuild of the outside bar, in-

cluding poolside seating, riverside service areas, under deck bar seating, and new bar equipment. We also have a permit to replace the vertical 2" x 2" deck railing with stainless steel cable railing. Once these projects are complete, we hope to raise the money to put a dining patio to the east of the outside bar (north of the club building inside the rope line. This will tie the firepit, bar, and patio into one open social area for member enjoyment.


