It won't be long now! We can now count the days when our boats are back in the water and we can enjoy a season full of good times!



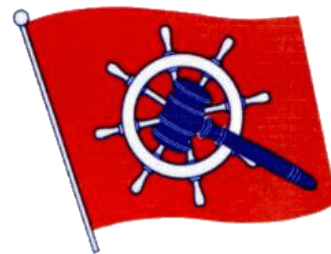

## District Director Gene McKeown

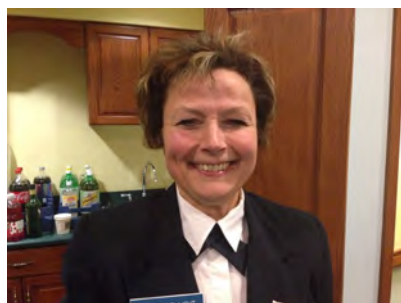
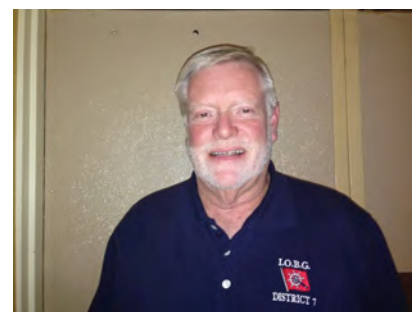


On Tuesday evening, February 10<sup>th</sup>, I attended the monthly GCBA membership meeting held at Western Reserve Yacht Club. At the meeting, John Popovich, IOBG member from South Shore Cruising Club and Political Action representative for GCBA, reported on two important issue that affect all boaters as well as all residence of northern Ohio.

First, Boat US has sent an email concerning the expansion of E-15 and the Renewable Fuel Act of 2015. You can find a form at Boat US that can be emailed to your House Representative. E-15 burns hotter and can damage rubber hoses and plastic parts on your boat.

Second, Senate Bill 1 is being fast tracked in the Ohio Senate. It deals with toxic algae and safe drinking water. You can read more about it by going to [www.ohiosenate.gov](http://www.ohiosenate.gov) and click on Latest News then on Majority Caucus and scroll down till you see toxic algae.

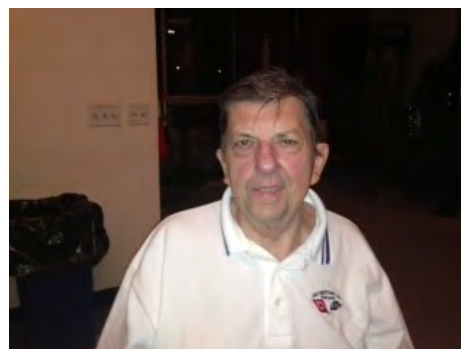

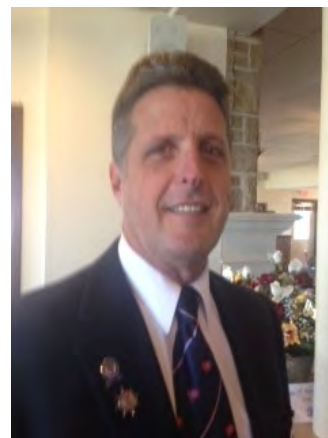


## Cleveland Central VP Tim Yearick
