The 33 ft boats are the ideal one-design racing auxiliary- no ratings or large expensive sail inventories are needed to be competitive. The rig makes it very easy for two people to sail or families to race. This year 25 to 30 boats are expected to compete in Vermilion. The event starts Tuesday August 9th with registration, with racing everyday till Sunday when the awards will be presented.


